



PORTSMOUTH HARBOUR TRIP AND VISIT TO PORTSMOUTH HISTORIC DOCKYARD THURSDAY 24TH JUNE 2010

Following our successful day out to Chichester last summer, we invite SPS members and their guests to join us for a day out in Portsmouth on Thursday 24th June, 2010.

The day will start with a 45 minute Harbour Tour with a lively commentary, so that you can discover why Portsmouth is one of the most important harbours in the world.

After lunch at Boat House No. 7, one of the Dockyard's restaurants, members can explore the Dockyard, at their leisure.

Points of interest include The National Museum of the Royal Navy, The Mary Rose Museum, HMS Victory, HMS Warrior and many other interesting exhibitions.

The cost of the visit to Portsmouth Historic Dockyard, including the Harbour Tour, a two-course lunch and entry to all the exhibitions and historic ships costs £24.00.

Portsmouth Harbour train station is just 200 metres from the main entrance. Coach and bus services also stop at The Hard Interchange just outside the main gate. The Gosport Ferry and Isle of Wight FastCat operate nearby.

There are 300 spaces, including 15 disabled spaces available at the Historic Dockyard car park on a first-come first-served basis and other car parks nearby.
