Project background

In order to ensure that the excavation is safe and does not affect the existing shore defences it is necessary to determine the ground conditions i.e. the depth of beach deposits and type and strength of the material below, so that an appropriate temporary retaining wall can be designed.

The variation of ground conditions under the proposed foot print of the barge therefore has to be checked. It is therefore proposed to use a hydraulic 360° excavator, on wide tracks, to excavate some trial holes over one or two tides. All holes will be backfilled with the arisings, prior on the same tide as the excavations.
